Paint booths/spray booths are power-vented structures that enclose a spraying operation to confine and limit vapor and spray through exhaust systems. When working in a paint booth, it's crucial to be aware of potential hazards to ensure safety. Here are some important warnings and precautions:

- 1. Flammable Materials: Paints, solvents, and coatings used in the booth are often flammable. Proper handling and storage are essential to prevent fires or explosions.
- 2. Prohibit flames, and sparks within 20 feet of the booth.
- 3. Toxic Exposure: Paints and solvents contain toxic substances and require special handing and PPE
- 4. Electrical extension cords should **not** be used inside the paint booth.
